### PROGRESSIVE REVENUE

#### HEALTH CARE

- Support An Act Strengthening Health Reform (the ACT!! Bill) - Strengthening Chapter 58 through enhanced access to care, affordable coverage, and employer responsibility

#### JOBS & WAGES

- Reform CORI to improve access to jobs and housing for people with CORI files

#### HOUSING

- Increase funding to the Massachusetts Rental Voucher Program (MRVP)
- Pass the Housing Bond Bill to maintain and build more affordable housing

#### EDUCATION

- Increase funding for all school districts to reduce class size, target additional resources to low-income districts, and require a study to determine future funding needs
